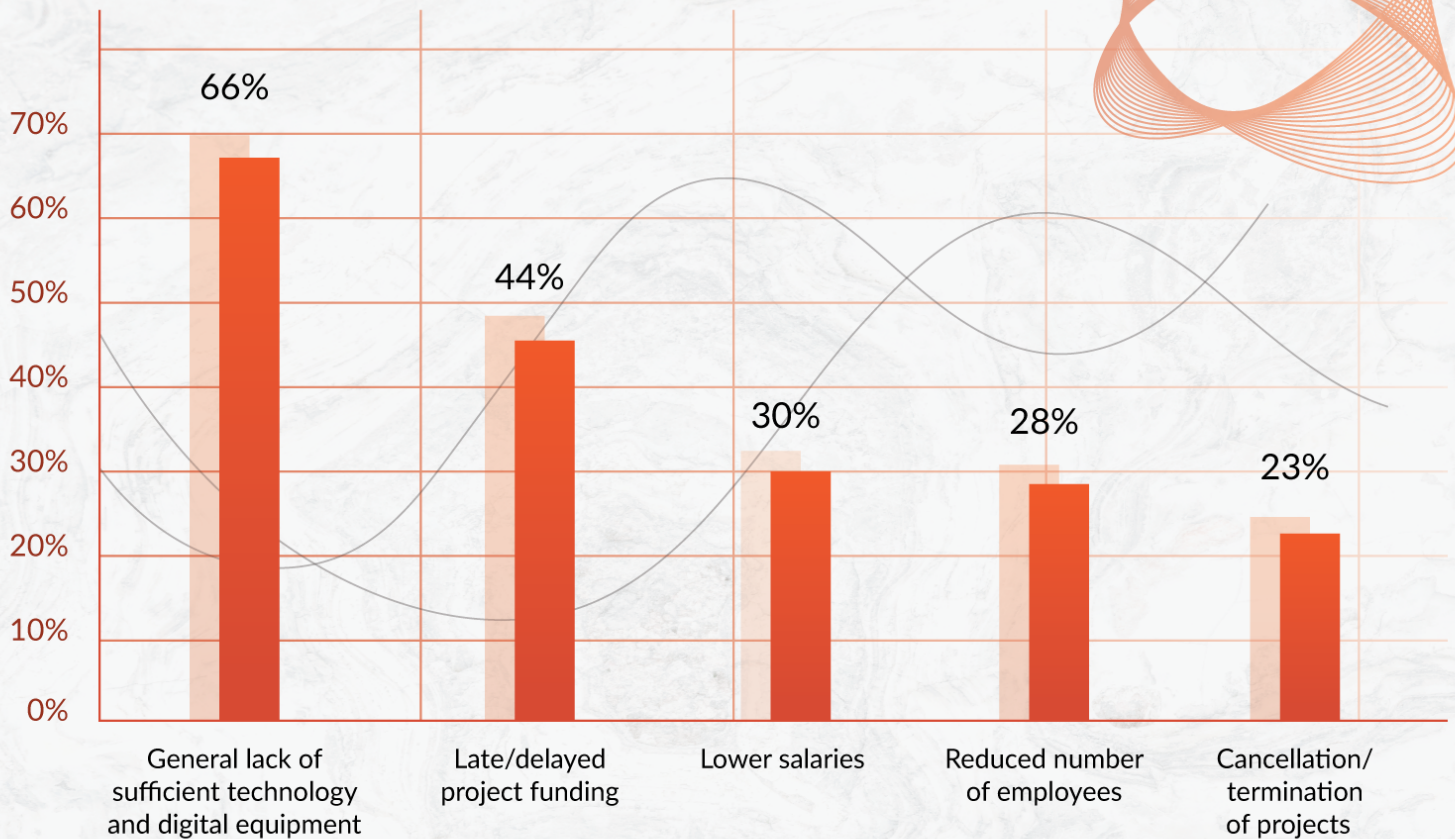


# IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 HEALTH CRISIS ON ACTIVITY AND CAPACITY OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS

34% of surveyed civil society organizations reported **lack of sufficient equipment for work at home**, while **66%** of them indicated **lack of sufficient technology and digital equipment in general**. Around **44%** of civil society organizations referred to **delays in project funding** due to the COVID-19 crisis, while around **23%** of them indicated **fully terminated/suspended funding for project activities** in that period.



*The survey was conducted on national representative sample comprised of 1300 respondents with  $\pm 2\%$  margin of error. Data are part of the survey research "Civic Engagement in the Republic of North Macedonia 2020-2021".*
