
## IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 HEALTH CRISIS ON ACTIVITY AND CAPACITY OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS

34% of surveyed civil society organizations reported lack of sufficient equipment for work at home, while 66% of them indicated lack of sufficient technology and digital equipment in general. Around 44% of civil society organizations referred to delays in project funding due to the COVID-19 crisis, while around 23% of them indicated fully terminated/suspended funding for project activities in that period.



The survey was conducted on national representative sample comprised of 1300 respondents with  $\pm$  2% margin of error. Data are part of the survey research "Civic Engagement in the Republic of North Macedonia 2020-2021".
