

THE SHARE OF YOUNG PEOPLE WHO SEE THEMSELVES LIVING ABROAD IN THE NEXT 5 YEARS IS INCREASING

High 40% of youth aged 16 to 29 years see themselves living abroad in the next 5 years, representing an increase by 9% compared to 2020 survey data and by 11% compared to 2021 survey data.



The survey was conducted on national representative sample comprised of 1300 respondents with $\pm 2\%$ margin of error. Data are part of the survey research "Civic Engagement in the Republic of North Macedonia 2020-2021-2022".
